



Preparation

We encourage you to take a few minutes to meditate on the Lord Who calls us and serves us through His Word and Sacraments.

Pray for those leading this Worship Service.

It should be noted that is customary to not pronounce the divine name, so out of respect we continue this tradition, also noting that God gave us His name because He wanted us to know Him (Ex. 3:14).

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at this congregation in the confession and glad confidence that, as He says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but His very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with Him and with one another. This union with Him and with one another assumes a common faith. Our Lord invites to His table those who trust His words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us, that they may show forth His death until He comes.

St. Paul encourages us to "Let a person examine himself then, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup" (1 Cor. 11:28). If you are unsure about what we teach, believe and confess, please know that should you not commune with us, we understand and appreciate your discretion.
